RESEARCH ONGOING FOR NATIONAL REGISTER NOMINATION

Downtown Owensboro, Inc. is collecting historical information on buildings and neighborhoods for possible inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places. Such designation enables property owners to receive maximum tax credits for investments in rehabilitating their buildings.

The objective of this project is to nominate to the National Register at least three districts of some 85 buildings and ten to twelve individual buildings.

DISTRICTS UNDER CONSIDERATION

- J.Z. MOORE ADDITION Bounded generally by 12th, Daviess, 14th and St. Ann Streets.
- PHILLIPS COURT NEIGHBORHOOD Includes some houses on Phillips Court and along almost two blocks of Frederica near the intersection.
- WEST FOURTH DOWNTOWN DISTRICT North side of 4th Street between Frederica and St. Ann.
- EAST MAIN AND CRITTENDEN DISTRICT -Surrounding the intersection of East 2nd and Crittenden Streets.

- 5. What were the neighborhoods surrounding these districts and buildings like at the turn of the century?
